Item:	Acceptable Student Wear:	Unacceptable Student Wear:
Hair	Clean, neat hair; hair that does not extend below the ear, collar or eyebrows (boys)	Hair colors that are not natural; hair that has more than 2” of bulk (boys); extreme styles (e.g. Mohawks, dreadlocks)
Pants/Shorts	Pants/shorts that are khaki, navy, black, brown or grey; Pants/shorts that are not tight or form-fitting; pants/shorts at the waist; shorts that are not shorter than 2” above the knee	Pants/shorts with holes, tears, frayed edges or so long they drag the ground; jeans or jean—style pants/shorts; pants/shorts made with Spandex or Lycra
Skirts	Skirts that are khaki, navy, black, brown or grey; skirts that are knee-length or longer	Skirts that are too tight; skirts that have front slits; skirts with slits higher than 2” above the knee; skirts made with Spandex or Lycra
Shirts	A collared oxford, polo shirt, or turtleneck which is solid in color; solid colored undershirts as undergarments only; polo shirts buttoned modestly; shirts that are appropriate size; shirts that can be tucked in at all times (boys)	Shirts that are tight, form –fitting or reveal the midriff; blouses; shirts made of a sheer material; t-shirts of any kind; shirts with logos larger than 3”; sleeveless shirts
Footwear	Shoes that are in good condition; shoes with shoelaces laced and tied (when applicable)	Flip-Flops; beach shoes or athletic sandals; slippers; combat-style boots
Outerwear	Solid-colored pullover vests, sweaters or turtleneck sweater or fleece; ASCS jackets only in classroom; approved shirts under all outerwear	Scarves; hooded or denim clothing; camouflage, trench coats and oversized or flannel shirts; garments with logos larger than 3” x 3”

Additional Guidelines:

- Shorts may be worn year-round
- Boys must wear belts at all times (3rd – 6th grade)
- Hats and sunglasses may not be worn in the building during school hours
- Aside from females wearing earrings, students may not wear piercings or plugs during school hours
- No excessive jewelry. Boys must keep necklaces/chains inside the shirt
- Sandals may be worn providing they have a strap across the back

DRESS DOWN DAYS

Periodically on Fridays students are allowed the privilege of dressing outside the dress code; these days are used as fundraisers for various classes, clubs, and organizations. On Relaxed Dress Days the Activities Dress Code may be followed with the following exceptions:

- Shorts should be no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee.
- Skirts must be knee length or longer.
- Hats/ sunglasses may not be worn in the building during school hours.
- Standard jewelry policy applies
- No flip flops, beach shoes, or athletic sandals of any kind may be worn.
- No hooded clothing is allowed in the classroom.

ACTIVITY DRESS CODE

Recognizing that many school activities, especially sports activities, are much more relaxed than the formal school day, we offer the following relaxed dress code* for such activities:

Item:	Acceptable Student Wear:	Unacceptable Student Wear:
Jeans/Pants	Must be clean, neat and gender appropriate	No tight-fitting, sagging pants, no hole, patches, torn areas or frayed edges; pant may not drag on the ground
Shorts	Shorts that are not shorter than 2" above the knee	No boxer shorts or tight shorts
Shirts/Tops	Shirts should be appropriate size	No sleeveless cut-out tee shirts, no thin strap tank tops, no halter tops, no bare mid-riffs and not too tight

*Any clothing with messages contrary to the principles of ASCS are not allowed.

*Be reminded that activity dress is to be worn to all athletic events, including those prior to the beginning of school.
